



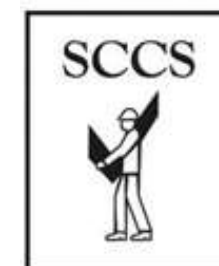
UKCA MARKING

A UKCA mark (UK Conformity assessed), formerly known as the CE mark, is a new UK product marking that is used for goods placed on the market in Great Britain. This is a manufacturer's declaration that their product meets the minimum requirements of a harmonised technical specification.

All Wareing buildings are manufactured at our works to comply with the British Standard 5502 for Agricultural Buildings & British Standard 5950/EN 1993 Eurocode 3 for Industrial Buildings and in June 2014, the company was awarded by the Quality marking for its products, certified to Execution Class 2 level. This validates that J Wareing & Son have the necessary Factory Production Control system and Welding Certificates in place and fully operational.
